## **GERMAN BEGINNER 1**



## Who should join this course?

This is an initial German language course for ten weeks. The course is designed for those who did not know or learn German previously. It includes ten (10) topics relating to simple and essential scenarios in daily lives.

Week 1	Greetings and goodbyes; Pronunciation; Numbers; Articles: der, die, das Special letters of the German alphabet
Week 2	Introductions (yourself, family members); Categorise some German nouns; Numbers up to 100; Countries; About the nominative case
Week 3	Express likes/dislikes/favourites; Formulate questions; Numbers up to 10000; Talk about hobbies; Use question words; Verb endings in the present tense
Week 4	Telling time; Birthdays; Days of the week; Months of the year; About the accusative case
Week 5	Reading and understanding basic German texts;  Describe leisure-time activities; Names of the seasons
Week 6	Recap of previous lessons; Currencies/money; Use modal verbs
Week 7	Shopping in Germany; Agree/disagree with someone; Different sections of a department store; Verbs "haben" and "sein"; Irregular verbs
Week 8	Names of quantifiers; Names of clothing; Adjective endings; The perfect tense
Week 9	Use public transport; Some prepositions; About the dative case
Week 10	Ordering food in a restaurant; Special dietry needs; Change an order
10 weeks, 2 hour session per week
