E EXPECTED OUTCOME

- ✓ Able to use group classifiers in certain times.
- ✓ Able to express time in many circumstance.
- ✓ Able to make fairly simple sentences.
- ✓ Able to compare things simply and shows preferences.
- ✓ Able to ask or prices and quantity.
