• Who should join this course?

This is an initial Thai language course for ten weeks. The course is designed for those who did not know or learn Thai previously. It includes ten (10) topics relating to simple and essential scenarios in daily lives.

Syllabus	
Week 1	Know Thai consonants, Tones, Vowels pronunciation, Basic sentences; Greeting, Thank, Sorry and Pronounces
Week 2	Introducing yourself; where from, what work do you do? Basic Yes/No Questions include asking ' is this yours? Whose is this? And Basic use of 'What is?' ' What about?'
Week 3	Basic Shopping words; Prices, Expensive or Cheap, Numbers, Directions, Asking Questions using 'Where at?' or 'Where', Positions, Places
Week 4	Expressing Feelings, Liking, Color and Meals/Drink and Transportations
Week 5	Times, Dates – Day, Week, Month, Year sentences
Week 6	Learning Past/Present/Future words, To doVerbs and 'ing'
Week 7	Learning how to express 'Want' and 'Need', Express by using 'not at all' or 'don't
Week 8	Restaurant situations; taste, how to order or asking questions
Week 9	Revisions, Family, Animals and Occupations
Week 10	Body; including words for clothing, Sickness; sore, headache
