Who should join this course?

Learners who have finished 20 hours of Thai Beginner 1.

Learners understand Thai alphabets and can write very simple Thai words.

The learners should have the ability to understand simple sentences and make simple conversations. The learners can ask and answer about name, nationality, time, simple direction and days during a week. They can also say sorry, thank you, greeting and good bye.

Learners want to learn more verbs, noun, vocabulary and improve in sentence structure and fluency.
