EXPECTED OUTCOME

By the end of this course the students will have:

- Ability to converse in most conversation
- Ability to argue and defend their opinion in Vietnamese
- Ability to listen to normal conversations
- Ability to understand some slang and colloquial expressions in Vietnamese language
- Ability to write and translate paragraphs or essay
- Ability to guess and spell the words from hearing the sound.

TUITION
